Carol's life was spent helping the next generation. A mother of six, she still had room for more. As a foster parent, Carol kept open arms for any little one in need. Locally, most know her as a pinnacle home daycare for four decades of children.

She refused to change her phone number in case any of her “kids” reached out and needed aid. “They all know that number,” she’d say, ready to help at a moment’s notice.

Carol did not drive. But she was the first call for many who needed a ride. Because she was the type you called first when stranded. The purest testament to the trust she created in all those who crossed her path. A helper of helpers.
