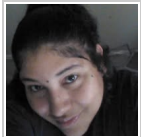

I hope you know that your love and compassion really did go a long way for me and you will forever be a part of me as I go through my journey of life!

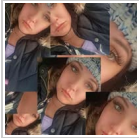

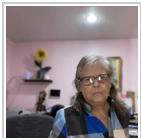
