Eddy H. Johnson, 77, of Kankakee, passed away Thursday (Jan. 18, 2018) at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee.

He was born March 24, 1940, in Watseka, the son of Louie and Tadie Johnson, of Danforth.

Surviving are his two kids, Scott Johnson, of Bourbonnais, and his daughter, Debbie and Mike Karraker, of Kankakee; two nieces, Dorthy and Mike Cresswell, of Watseka, and Manord and Ruthy Jensen, of Ashkum; four grandchildren, Mike, Matt, Jenny and Mark Karraker; and one great-grandchild, Luke Karraker.
