Jane Elizabeth Subbert, 86, of St. Anne, passed away peacefully at her home on Tuesday, December 13, 2022.

She was born on February 24, 1936, in Lowell, IN, the daughter of Wesley and Mary “Jeanette” (Nichols) Schilling. On September 2, 1954, she married Marvin Subbert.

Jane worked for Imperial International and Montgomery Wards and owned her own insurance company for 30 years. Jane was also devoted to her church, Asbury United Methodist Church.
