Milford, Michigan, at the international race. Ken was a co-founder of the local Rip Tide Remote Control Boat Club. He also enjoyed traveling the Midwest racing his remote control boats.

Surviving are his sister and brother in law, Nancy and Terry DuTour of Aroma Park.

Also surviving are a brother and sister in law, Kirk and Kaye Stang of Kankakee

He will be greatly missed by his aunts, uncles, nieces and nephews. Ken had many friends among them his fishing buddies and remote control boat friends, who were like his second family.

A memorial service will be held in St. Anne in conjunction with the Rip Tide Remote Control Boat Club Regatta that will be dedicated to Ken in June.

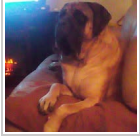

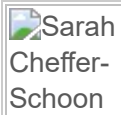
