Lindsey is preceded in death by her grandma, Melenese Reeves; and a very special friend, Jace Held.

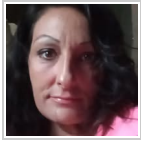

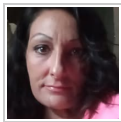

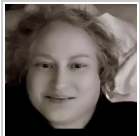

We talked about hanging out for girl time when she was out of rehab and I was out of jail. I am sorry that we didn't have the opportunity. Rest in peace, sweet girl. 😭 U will be missed.
