Marilyn A. (Mau) Bottorff, 73, of Bourbonnais, passed away Wednesday, October 29, 2025, at Riverside Medical Center. She was born November 29, 1951 in Kankakee to Albert and Elizabeth (Wheeler) Mau. Marilyn married Rev. David Bottorff on June 19, 1982, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee.

Marilyn grew up in rural Herscher. She graduated from Herscher High School in 1969, and Illinois State University in 1973 with a degree in music education.

God used Marilyn to reach out to people through her musical abilities as an elementary music teacher in Herscher, leader of a children's choir at St. John Lutheran Church in Darien, and most of all, caring for special needs children as a teacher's aide in the Hinsdale school system for 18 years.

Marilyn attended Trinity Lutheran Church in Herscher from birth, St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee, IL through 1987, and St. John Lutheran Church in Darien, IL from 1987-2018 and again in retirement at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Kankakee since 2018.

Marilyn is survived by her husband David of Bourbonnais, and two sons and

daughters-in-law, Benjamin (Stephanie) Bottorff of Bolingbrook, and Samuel (Melissa) Bottorff of Bradley.
